

World's Biggest Crane-Bigge 125D AFRD

Bigge Crane & Rigging in the USA has its 125D AFRD, which it describes as the world's largest capacity crane at radius. Bigge gives the capacity of the ARFD as 7,500 US tons (6,800 tons) on 300 feet (91 m) of main boom and 4,000 tons (3,630 tons) with 560 feet (171 m) of main boom. Fixed jibs will be available in excess of 1,000 tons (907 tones) capacity and 200 feet (61 m) long, according to Pete Ashton, vice president of major projects.

“The market continues to demand higher capacity machines to accommodate accelerated construction methods,” says Ashton. Features distinguishing the AFRD are “high speed performance machinery for slewing, hoisting and booming, exceptional and unmatched capacity at radius, automatic self levelling, state-of-the-art safety features, Modular components for ease of assembly and economical transportation,” Ashton explains.
